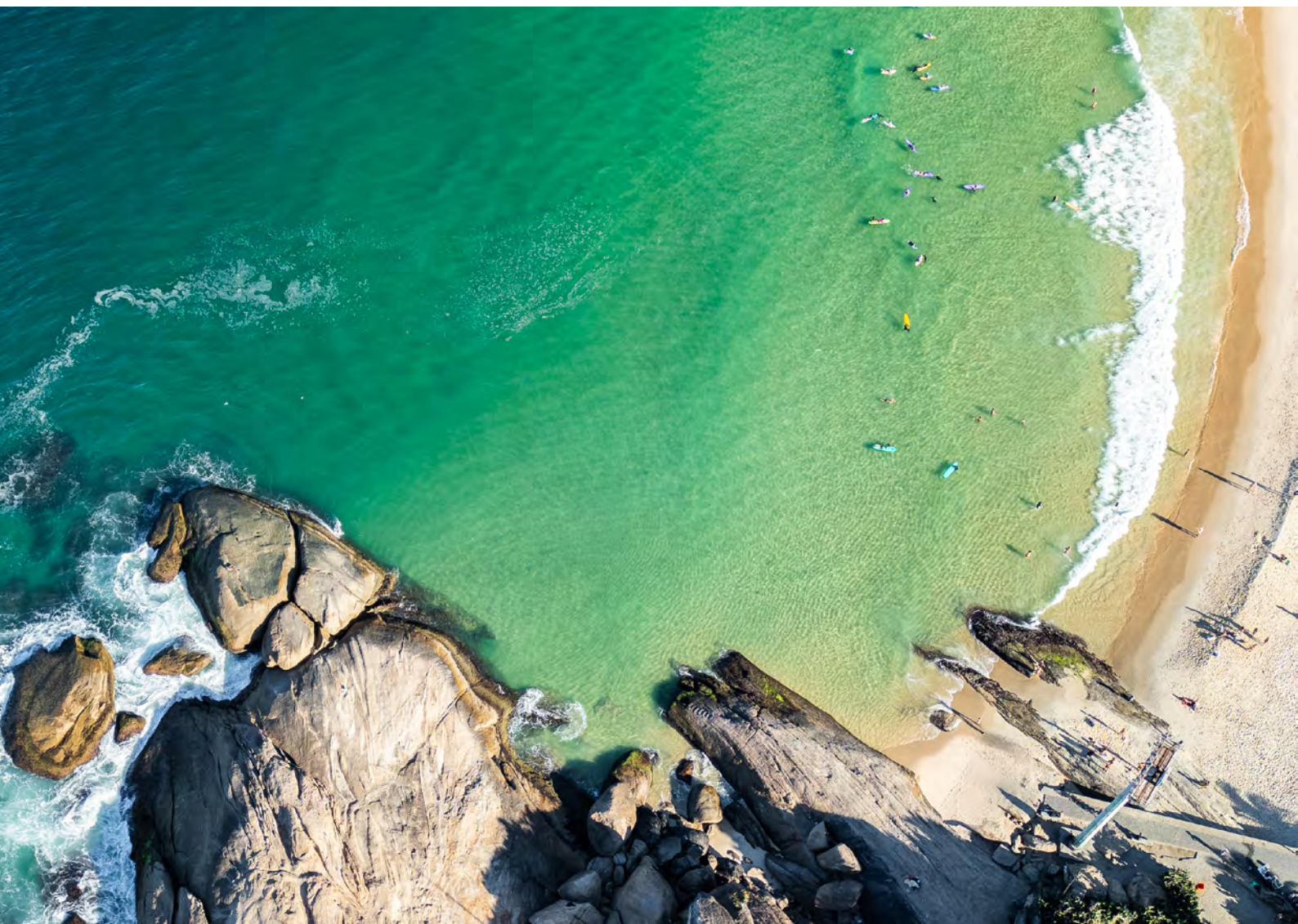


# Surf Lesson at Arpoador
