Boat Tours

Enjoy looking the perspective of Salvador city from the sea on this tour through the All Saint's Bay. Destinations may include *Frades' Island*, home to the beach of *Ponta de Nossa Senhora de Guadalupe*, or *Maré Island*, where you'll find *Itamoabo Beach*, which features crystal-clear warm waters, also known as the endpoint of religious maritime processions in the city.

Fasano Salvador Hotel offers catering service with our chef and staff for service during the tour.

Sailing Classes

Recommended for adventure lovers, enjoy the ride through All Saint's Bay aboard a sailboat, where you can learn basic concepts of operating and conducting a vessel.



Yoga Class

Yoga is an ancient philosophy originating from India, aiming primarily to awaken a sense of well-being, while promoting muscle stretching, memory improvement, sleep, concentration, as well as physical and mental relaxation.

Experience a private class in our Fitness Center, located on the Rooftop overlooking the Bay of All Saints.

Sunrise Yoga Class

To begin the day in a balanced and active way, try the Sunrise Yoga, which is held on the beautiful hotel rooftop during sunrise.





Tai Chi Chuan Class

The Chinese martial art *Tai Chi Chuan* combines ancient body exercises known as *Chi Kung* and *Tao Yin*. Both focus on areas such as breathing, concentration, and principles of Traditional Chinese Medicine. The smooth practice style promotes muscle relaxation and is a great recommendation for winding down at the end of the day.

Tai Chi Chuan Sunrise Class

The experience combines the natural light of dawn with the landscape of the Bay of All Saints, promoting a connection of body and mind.





Hawaiian Canoe

The Hawaiian Canoe classes take place at *Praia da Preguiça* with two schedule options: at dawn or late afternoon. The route includes passing by the city's main beaches, as well as stops for swimming. The canoe accommodates up to 6 people, and the classes are suitable for beginners.

Visit at the Historic Center

Considered a World Heritage Site by UNESCO, the Historic Center of Salvador is an area that provides an encounter with the origins of the country. The walking tour, accompanied by an accredited guide, passes through points such as the Lacerda Elevator, the Church *Nossa Senhora Rosário dos Pretos*, the museums *Casa do Carnaval* and *Cidade da Música da Bahia*. Lasting one hour, the activity can be extended up to 2 hours and 15 minutes to visit the streets of *Santo Antônio Além do Carmo*. There is also an option of doing the route in an electric cart.

Dance Workshop

Held in the Historic Center, the dance workshop aims to highlight the traditional rhythms and dances of Bahia. Passed down through different generations, the bodily culture remains alive through well-known genres such as *Samba* and *Capoeira*, which blend with *Maculelê* and Afro Dance.



Guided Bike Tour

With a summer-like climate for most of the year, the coast of Salvador boasts over 100km of seacoast. For bike tour enthusiasts, we have adapted the traditional itinerary to encompass the city's main beaches and panoramic views on this guided tour.

Music Workshop

The Music Workshop allows you to experience Salvador's culture through traditional instruments such as percussion, *berimbau*, and *olodum*. Learn more about the different rhythms present in Bahia's culture, taught by local masters and instructors at the *Mestre Bimba* Association, located in the Historic Center.



Sightseeing Helicopter Tour

Discover the city's main attractions seen from above. The aerial route includes the Bay of All Saints, the *Tororó* Dam and a unique view of the Historic Center.

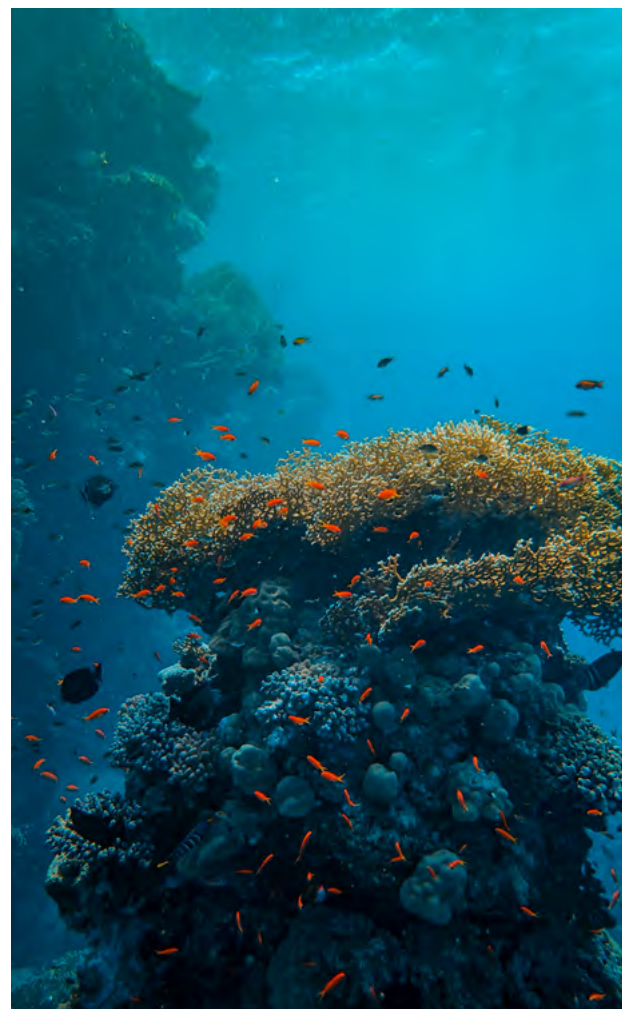


Diving

Explore the marine biodiversity of the Bay of All Saints during this immersion dive, which can reach depths of up to 12 meters. The activity is conducted with the assistance of an accredited instructor, lasts two hours, and no diving certification is required.

The History of “A tarde” Building

One of the most beautiful Art Deco constructions in Bahia, the former headquarters of “A Tarde” newspaper, listed as a Cultural Heritage Site of Bahia, holds intricate details in all its spaces. History and architecture enthusiasts, join this guided tour with a historian and learn more about the buildings that houses Hotel Fasano Salvador and its surroundings, such as *Castro Alves* Square and Chile Street.





Chef Fasano Bambini

Cooking can be a fun and educational activity for parents and children. This class uses recipes from Italian cuisine to explain measurements and recipes, as well as kitchen safety tips for the little ones.



Bahia's Cooking Class

Enjoy the aromas and flavors of local cuisine while learning how to prepare some of Bahia's most beloved dishes, such as spaghetti with seafood or *Moqueca*. The class is conducted by a specialized chef.

Mixology Class

For those who want to learn more about the world of mixology, this practical class taught by the Bartender of Fasano Salvador features recipes for classic cocktails and original creations.



Private Dinner on the Rooftop

Ideal for a special moment for couples or events with up to nine guests, the dinner held on the Rooftop is an invitation to contemplate the view of the Bay of All Saints in an intimate and totally privileged ambience for the occasion. The menu, consisting of up to five courses, is crafted based on classic Italian gastronomy recipes and personalized according to the guests' preferences for each event. The wine pairing is curated with labels endorsed by the Group's Executive Sommelier, Manoel Beato, along with a selection of original creations and classic cocktails.

Wine Cellar Dinner

One of Fasano's highlights is the climate-controlled wine cellar. Accessible via a spiral staircase in original Art Deco style, the space can accommodate small events for up to 6 people in a private atmosphere.
